

Registration and Policies

Individual, private instruction for beginners and experienced students, is available in piano, voice, clarinet and Guitar for the Summer Session. The instruction, adapted to the student's age and experience, is offered in thirty minute, forty-five minute, and one hour blocks. Lessons will be taught weekly at Second Baptist Church and will be scheduled at a mutually agreeable time between the student and the Instructor. There is an non-refundable registration fee of \$10 per student unless currently enrolled. For additional registrations for the SAME STUDENT (e.g. one student taking piano AND voice), the registration fee is \$5 per additional area. Tuition is payable by the semester session, and the cost is \$19 per HALF hour of private instruction. Tuition may be paid in full at anytime before the scheduled opening of the Conservatory for the semester. You may pay all or any part of the tuition and fees with cash, check or credit card. We



accept MasterCard and Visa. Credit card payments can be made during regular office hours over the phone or in person in the church office. Tuition for Summer Session is due **before** the opening day with the of the session. Lessons will not be taught until all fees are paid in full. No lessons will be made up if they are missed due to late payments, and the student will be charged the full session fee. Additionally, there will be a 20% late charge for all unpaid balances.



An attempt to make-up lessons will be made if twenty-four hours or more notice is given to the Instructor prior to a lesson (limit **ONE** per session). It is the student's responsibility to notify the Instructor if a lesson is to be missed for any reason. If the Instructor cannot be reached, the student should notify the Conservatory office at 923-7101. Failure to notify the Instructor or the Conservatory will result in no make-up lesson, and the student will be charged for the missed lesson.

An attempt to make-up lessons will be made if twenty-four hours or more notice is given to the Instructor prior to a lesson (limit **ONE** per session). Guitar Pick Style Solo. This year 178 students participated in Festival. Our students received 70 Superior Ratings and 23 Excellent Ratings. Students of all ages are encouraged to participate. This year four adults joined our Festival day and were encouraged by the judges to keep music a part of their lives.
