## Planning Center Online

If you need help with Planning Center Online (PCO), please do not hesitate to call the church office (923.7101) and ask for either Bro. Dawson or Wendy Shaw. It's a great tool to see what's coming up in the days and months ahead! Don't forget that you can listen or "rehearse" with the songs that have been loaded into Planning Center. We are trying to load all the songs as we come to them. Here's a step by step list on how to listen to the songs:

1. Log in to PCO
2. Click on Sunday Morning ( or Sunday Night if applicable)
3. Click on the date of the service you wish to rehearse
4. Look to the far right for the button "Rehearse" and hover over it
5. Click "Media Player"
6. Choose which song you would like to "Rehearse"
