Outreach

Intentionally touching our community with the gospel

Neighborhood Blitz Team

The purpose of this ministry is outreach with a personal touch. Blitz teams will go into the neighborhoods surrounding our church and knock on doors. We want our neighbors to know that we are here and that we care about them. Blitz team members will strategically work through various neighborhoods going door to door attempting to connect with the unchurched and lost. Teams will share information about our church and our desire to minister and serve their families. Team members will look for opportunities to talk about spiritual things and will be prepared to share the good news with those they encounter. These teams will work closely with the prayer walking ministry and will strategically cover an area in prayer a week or more before the blitz teams enter that area.

Blitz team members should possess a desire to reach out and need to develop a heart for their community. They should be good listeners and willing to share the love of Jesus. Additional training in sharing your faith will be available.

Correspondence Ministry

The purpose of this ministry is to begin to reach out into the community with a personal touch through the lost art of letter writing. Team members will write letters and cards to first-time visitors, absentee members, shut-ins, the bereaved and those celebrating births or a new marriage. Through information gathered at Second and in the local newspapers we will take time to write a personal letter celebrating blessings, showing concern and sharing God's love.

Team members need to be willing to write personal letters and have a desire to make a personal touch on our community.

Phone Call Ministry

The purpose of this ministry is to begin to reach out into the community with a personal touch through a phone call. Team members will use their cell phones to make phone calls to local residents that have recently established new phone service and ask them to take part in a short questionnaire. Through information gathered, team members will be able to determine if these folks are prospects for our church, tell them about various ministry opportunities and possibly share the gospel. The last question on the survey gives the individual called an opportunity to hear the gospel if they desire to do so.

Team members need to furnish their own cell phones and make local calls from a list provided.

Ministry To The Hospitalized

The purpose of this ministry is to make a personal touch on those in the local hospital who may not have a pastor or a church family to pray for them and love them in the midst of their illness/hospitalization. Team members will visit local hospitals weekly to minister to patients and others they might encounter.

Team members will share words of encouragement, information about our church, pray for those who allow it and if possible share the good news of Jesus Christ.

Sunday School Outreach

Sunday School is the foundational ministry in our church for reaching people with the gospel and then preparing them to be Great Commission Christians. Sunday School is evangelism and ministry in the context of a Bible study. It is the church organized to fulfill the Great Commission. Every class should be organized and involved in contacting, visiting and reaching out to its visitors, absentee members and prospects. Church information, additional S.S. literature, evangelism tools and class statistics will be available every Monday thru Wednesday night for class members to use in reaching out. Wednesday nights provide an ideal time to reach out while other family members and children are involved in ministry on campus.

Victory Sports

Recreation Outreach and Leadership Training

Victory Sports continues to be an incredible ministry for touching families in our community with the gospel. This addition to our sports and recreation ministry will help develop and equip leaders and potential leaders to be successful in their ministry role at a greater level.

Team members will participate in strategic planning, receive practical and foundational training in sports outreach and participate in actual outreach ministry through Victory Sports.

Hands and Hearts

Acts of kindness and service that demonstrate the love of Jesus

Nursing Home Teams

This ministry exists to go into the local nursing homes and love and minister to their residents. These teams will present a short worship service with a devotional lesson and then visit and minister to the residents and workers in the facility.

Team members will divide into smaller teams to work and serve in various nursing homes in the area.

Widow/Shut-in Teams

This ministry exists to reach out to widows and shut-ins who are connected to our church. These folks are often unable to attend services regularly or have special needs that the team can meet. This ministry is primarily a care and concern ministry. Team members will divide into smaller teams and work to serve, love and encourage our widows and shut-ins.

Senior Adult/Single Mom Car Care Team

This ministry exists to offer a helping hand to our Senior Adults and Single Moms who need some minor repairs on their vehicle. Oil changes, wiper blades and other small repairs will be provided for these folks while they serve and minister on Wednesday nights. Replacement parts will be paid for by the vehicle owner and our car care team will provide the labor for free.

Team members will work each Wednesday on vehicles at the bus barn.

Craft Teams

Some folks are crafty and just love to work with their hands. This ministry exists to allow these folks an opportunity to do what they love and provide a gift of love to some folks in need. The crafts produced will be used in our Nursing Home, Hospital and Shut-in ministries.

Team members will work each Wednesday to produce crafts that can be given in Christian love.

Lawn Care & Repair Teams

This ministry exists to lend a helping hand to those who need a little extra help caring for their lawn or making minor repairs to their home. Team members will work weekly to meet needs and share the love of Christ in a tangible way. Families with deployed members, shut-ins, senior adults, single parents and anyone else who needs a little help will greatly benefit from this service ministry.

College Student Care Ministry

College students sometimes get homesick or just need a pick me up. The purpose of this ministry is to provide a word of encouragement and a care package to college students while they are away from home.

Team members will pray for these students, provide a small care package and a note of encouragement to our college students who are away at school.

Literacy and Language Missions

Friends of Internationals

This ministry exists to share the love of Jesus with the international families that are moving into our community. Warner Robins is growing in this area and rapidly drawing people from other cultures and countries. This ministry gives us an opportunity to impact the world with the gospel right here within our own city limits.

Team members will work with international families to help them adjust to living in our community and to answer questions they have while helping them better learn the English language. Through Bible studies, sports camps, hand-on learning activities and conversation, team members will have the opportunity to show and share the love of Jesus and the good news of salvation.
